There is also a great need for Christmas quilts as well, and who doesn't love making those for children and teens? To make it more fun, each guild member who turns in quilts or totes for Bright Hopes between May 7 and September 30 will earn points, and prizes will be awarded based on the number of points accumulated.

Points will be tallied as follows:

1. tote = 2 points
2. quilt top = 5 points
3. completed quilt = 10 points

Submit as many items as you like, using your own fabric or kits provided by the committee. Report your volunteer hours for each item. Prizes will be awarded in each of the three categories.

There will also be a grand prize, a \$50 gift card, for overall points. In case of a tie for the grand prize, the winner will be chosen by a drawing. Prizes will be announced and delivered in November.

If you are unable to submit a quilt or tote, please consider donating a quilt-related item as a prize. Prizes may include such items as quilt shop gift cards, fabric, books, or patterns in good condition, etc. More prizes = more fun!!
