

Roosting Robin Round Four

Are you having a good time with your birdie here? We'd love to hear how it's coming along and what choices you make so be sure to send pics to wendyquilter9@gmail.com.

For this round, we're adding a row of blocks, so we'll help a bit with the math, and you will be the designer!

Your top should measure 48 1/2" at this point, so you can choose from several block sizes to work with. You can also choose to add a complete square border of blocks or just add a row to the top and bottom of the top to make a rectangular quilt.

Option 1: A square quilt with a complete set of border blocks

Block Size	# Blocks/Side	Total Blocks	Finished Size
4"	12	52	56 1/2"
6"	8	36	60 1/2"
8"	6	28	64 1/2"
12"	4	20	72 1/2"

Option 2: A rectangular quilt with a row of border blocks on only two sides of the quilt

Block Size	# Blocks/Side	Total Blocks	Finished Size
4"	12	24	56 1/2" x 48 1/2"
6"	8	16	60 1/2" x 48 1/2"
8"	6	12	64 1/2" x 48 1/2"
12"	4	8	72 1/2" x 48 1/2"

Ready? Set? Just choose a block, make the total number of blocks required, sew the appropriate number of blocks together to make the border, and add them to your top. See you next month!
