

Rose Garden Quilt Block from Slice of Pi Quilts

1 flower is 6 ½" wide x 12 ½" tall.

For the row: Make 10 flowers. No Spacers Needed!

For 1 flower

Flower color A: 4 3 ½" squares

Flower color B: 4 2" squares (center)

Flower colors are shown alternating.

Stem & Leaves: 2 2" x 3 ¼" rectangles
1 1" x 6 ½" rectangle

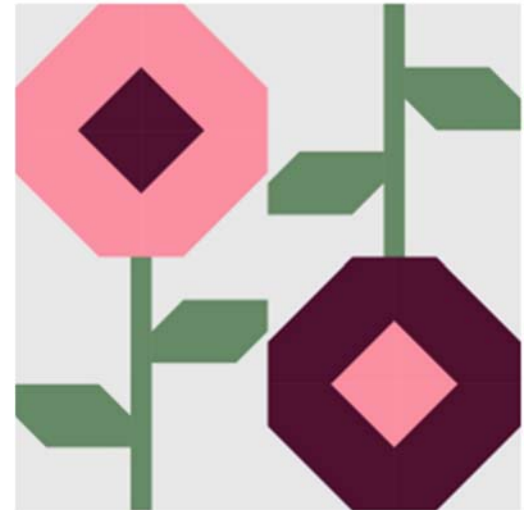
Background

4 2 ½" squares

4 1 ¼" squares

2 ¾" x 3 ½" rectangles

2 ¾" x 2" rectangles



Assembly

1. Use a chalk pencil or disappearing ink pen to draw a diagonal line on the back of all Flower B color 2" squares, Background 2 ½" squares, and Background 1 ¼" squares.
2. Place a Flower Color B 2" square in one corner of a Flower Color A 3 ½" square (right sides together). Sew on the diagonal line as shown below. Trim ¼" away from seam line. Press. Repeat to make four.
3. Place a Background 2 ½" square in the opposite corner of a unit created in step 3 (right sides together). Sew on the diagonal line as shown below. Trim ¼" away from seam line. Press. Repeat with all four units.



4. Sew all four units together as shown above. (Use scant ¼" seam.) Press seams as desired.
5. Place two Background 1 ¼" squares in opposite corners of a Leaf 2" x 3 ¼" rectangle (right sides together) as shown below. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" away from seam line. Press.

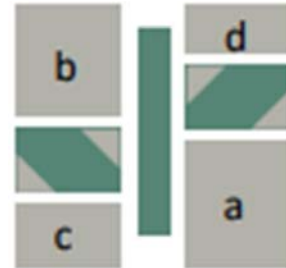


6. Place the Background 1 ¼" squares in the other two corners to create a mirror image of the units created in step 5.



- Lay out all block pieces as shown.
Pieces labeled a & b are $3\frac{1}{4}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$
Pieces labeled c & d are $3\frac{1}{4}'' \times 2''$

- Sew Stem and leaves together, then sew flower to stem.



One way to make the row of roses ---
