

## Sunflower block 12" finished

### Cut

Gold/yellow

8 - 2 ½" x 4 ½"

4 - 1 ½" squares

Brown Center

1 - 4 ½" square

Green Leaf

2 ½" x 10"

Background

4 - 2 1/2" x 4 ½"

2 1/2" x 10"



### Assembly

1. Sew the green and background 10" strips together, press, and then subcut into 2 1/2" wide sets.
2. Sew a background 2 ½" x 4 ½" piece to each of the two patches. Press.
3. Draw a diagonal on each of the 1 ½" squares. Use the stitch-and-flip method to sew one gold square to the large brown square in each of the corners. Trim and press.
4. Draw a diagonal on each of the 2 1/2" background squares. Use the stitch-and-flip method to sew onto the 2 1/2" x 4 ½" yellow rectangles. Make sure that the diagonals all go the same way. Trim and press.
5. Sew the yellow rectangles into pairs.
6. Arrange the pieces into a 9 patch for sewing. Make sure the green square touches a yellow rectangle. Sew and press.

For the Row: Make 6 sunflower blocks. No spacers needed!
