

## Totally TULIP Block 9" x 17" from Missouri Star

Missouri Star has YouTube video titled Totally Tulips

Cutting for 1 block

Flower: 4 charm squares

Stem: 1 ½" x 8 ½"

Background: 4 2 ½" squares

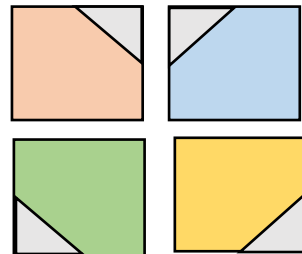
2 5" squares

Leaf: 2 charm squares

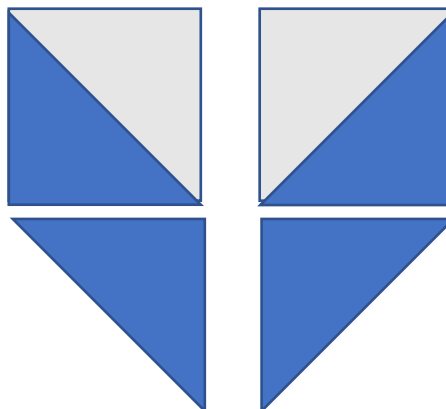


Assembly:

1. Mark 1 diagonal on each of the background squares.
2. Sew 1 2 ½" square to 1 corner of each of the flower squares. (stitch and flip). Trim corners.
3. Match 1 background square with 1 leaf square right sides together. Sew on both sides of the diagonal line and cut half square triangles apart. Do the second leaf square the same way. Press and trim the 4 half square triangles to 4 ½".
4. Sew the flower squares together. In the top row, the triangles are in the center seam. In the bottom row, the triangles are on the bottom outside.



5. Sew the leaf half square triangles. Notice that the left side is opposite diagonal from the right. You can't turn one upside down to get the other.



6. Sew the stem between the two leaf pieces.
7. Sew the bottom leaf and stem piece to the flower top.

FOR THE ROW:

Make 6 blocks.

Additional Background pieces:

Spacers: 4 1 ¾" x 19"

Stagger: 6 2 ½" x 9"

Add the stagger pieces to the TOP of 3 blocks, and to the BOTTOM of the other 3 blocks.

Add spacer pieces between the finished blocks.

Sew the blocks together.

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
