ZigZag Jellyroll

The picture is 16 twelve inch blocks which takes 32 strips. If you do 20 blocks, 4X5, then you use 40 strips, the complete jellyroll.

- 1. Each block takes 2 strips. Try to sort your roll into light-dark or some other order.
- 2. Sew pairs of strips together. You will have 16 pairs for the quilt to the right.
- 3. Press and cut into 4.5" pieces. You should have 9 pieces.
- Then lay them out. This is an alternate block quilt. So half of the blocks are laid out one way and the other half the other way.
- 5. Please note in the picture. The pink blocks have a horizontal block in the center and the purple block has a vertical block. And NO you can not just turn them. The darks and the lights will be wrong.
- 6. So essentially you have a 12 inch nine patch.
- 7. Then assemble the blocks following the picture.
