



President Betty Opiela called the meeting to order. Minutes were approved as written. Treasurer's report is as follows: Operating fund = $\frac{16,994.71}{}$ Reserve fund = \$ 40,311.30/ Total = \$57,306.01.

The President reported that tables and chairs from the storage area have been moved to Trinity United Methodist Church and other items will be picked up by Youth Alternatives on the 15 of October.

Newsletter: Lois Beauchamp reported the newsletter was delivered to the printer early. She did not know why the newsletter was so late in being delivered.

Programs: Holly Nelson reported that Friday and Saturday workshops for this month both have sufficient members to be held. Jean Powell will act as hostess for our presenter. Andrea Brown has volunteered to assist Holly with registration of members for workshops.


