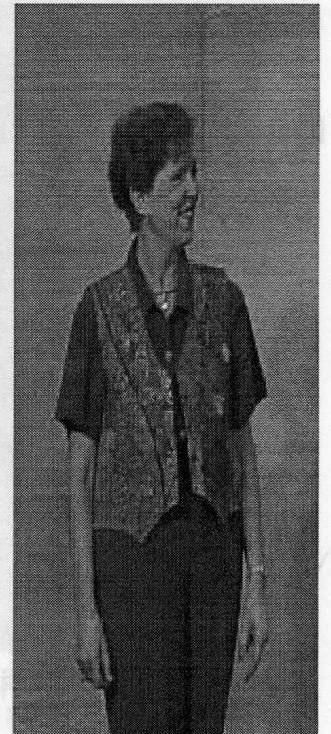

Operating Fund: \$15,418.97 Reserve Fund: \$46,016.48 Total: \$61,435.45

Larry announced that we have had a **request** for a quilt from the **San Antonio Children's Museum** to be used for the Silent Auction in their upcoming fundraiser. This request has been approved and a quilt will be provided.

A note from **Youth Alternatives** was read by Larry. It stated that they will be celebrating their 28th anniversary, Tuesday, September 14th, and invited guild members to join them for lunch.

**Programs:** Kitty Janiga said we will have **Irma Gail Hatcher** for our program presenter next month. There are still spaces available for her classes.

Kitty also asked members to **make yo-yo's** and bring them so they may be collected and used for our holiday celebration. She also announced that our policy for workshops will remain as stated in our Policy Statements: no refunds are made unless the space can be filled from a waiting list.

Special Events: **Houston Bus Trip** – Mary Storey announced that members may contact her to sign up and pay for the Houston bus trip if they are interested.

**Winter Retreat** – Kris Thomson said the Winter Retreat will be held January 14th 15th and 16th and the cost will be \$175.00. If interested in attending, contact Kris.

**Quilt Show Challenge** - Holly Nelson said the fabric for the Quilt Show Challenge is available for \$5.00 per fat quarter. She read the requirements for the quilt challenge and said we have a year to complete our projects for next year's show.

**Parliamentarian:** Candace Tull stated that soon calls would be made by the **nominating committee** to fill spaces which will be vacated at the end of the year. She made a request for people to be willing to help when they are called to serve and said this is a good way to "give back" to your guild.

Meeting adjourned at 10:16. There were 112 members and many guests.

Programs: Kitty Janiga asked about the possibility of having classes on

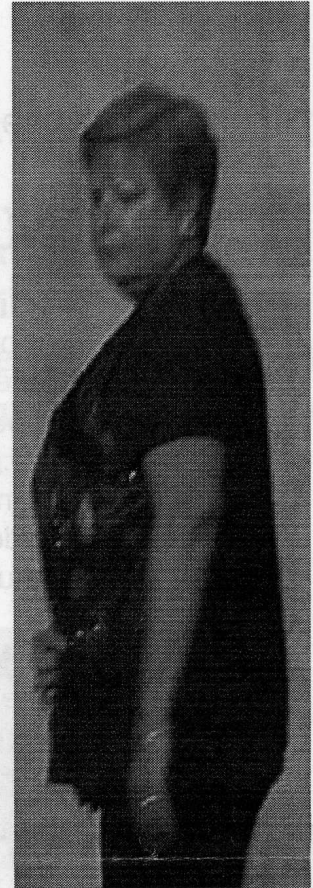

## "Cracked TILES"

This is the block that Jan Wildman showed us in a quilt she had made. The two-color block can make a diagonal design.

It should be easy to make several or lots.

6 1/2" block. **Finished size is 6"**

Color 1 BLUE      Color 2 Purple

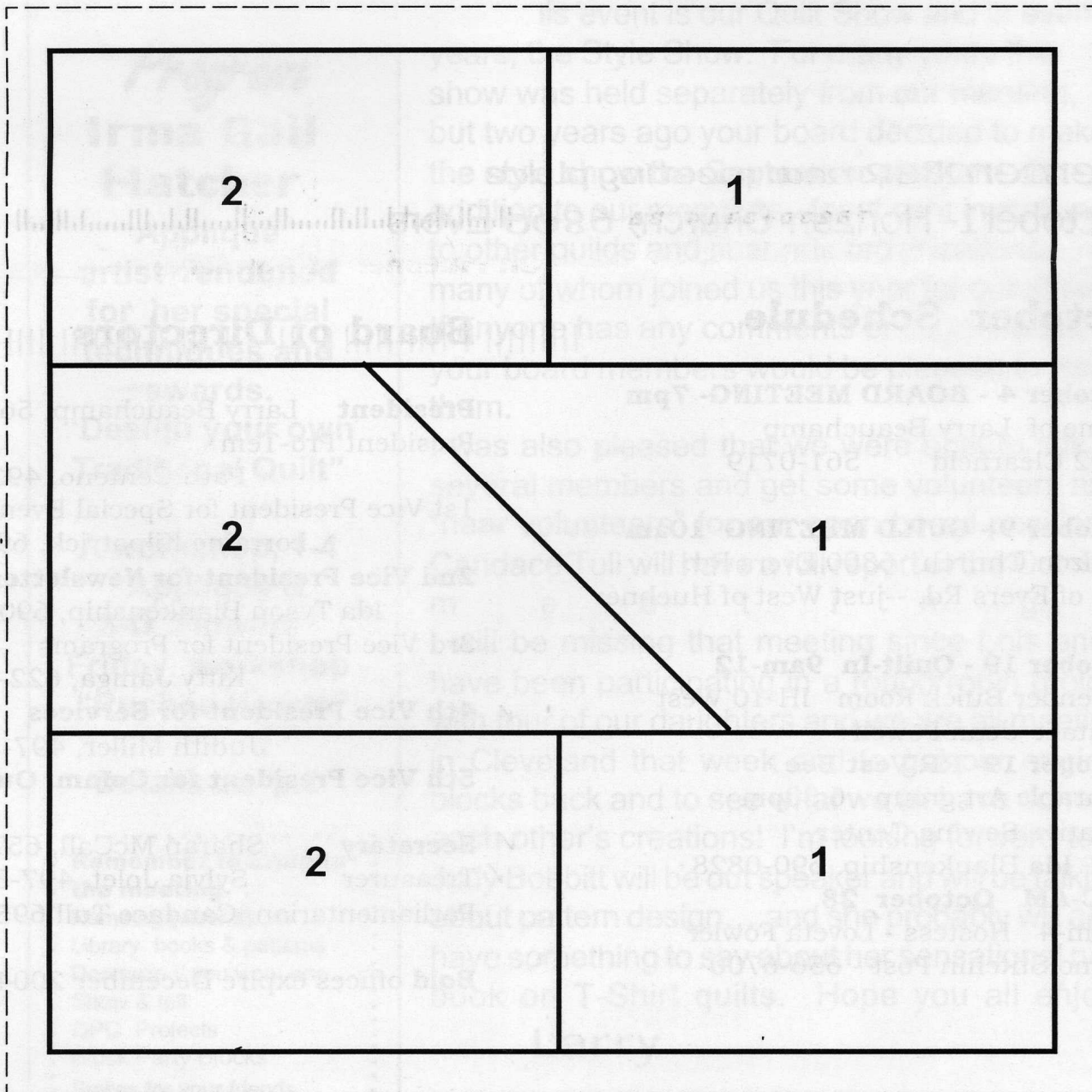
Can be cut with 2.5" strips.

Please use solids or monotone, or small prints that say one color.  
Please use all cotton, pre-washed fabrics.

Pin your name on a paper tag for each block
